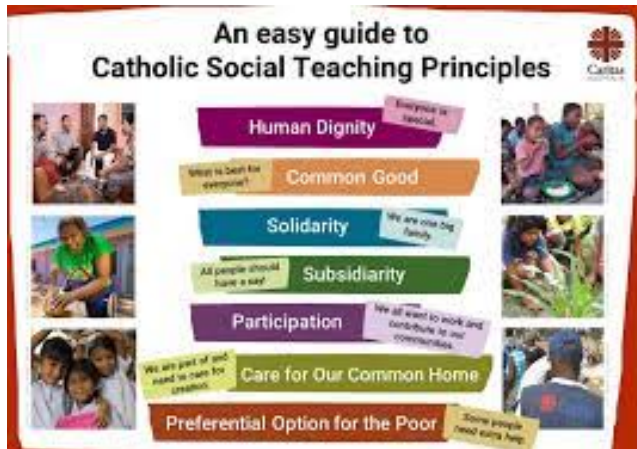


Catholic Social Teaching from 4P 2025
